

NSW Government supports Greener + Cleaner Air Conditioning

The NSW Department of Energy, Utilities and Sustainability (DEUS) today announced that Energy Conservation Systems Pty Ltd, (ECS) has successfully applied for funding to support the application of absorption chilling in the NSW market.



Absorption chilling uses heat energy, maybe waste heat from a manufacturing process, heat from a generator engine, even heat from solar hot water to create chilled water. It not only reduces demand on already stretched electricity networks it also results in lower electricity bills and can significantly cut greenhouse emissions.

The funding totaling up to \$ 500,000 will be available on a first in first served basis via Energy Conservation Systems.
